

# Chichiboulie

## Patchwork Robin Ornament



Here is your template for a *Chichiboulie Robin Ornament*.

I recommend printing your bird onto heavy weight paper, Epson heavy weight matte paper (167g) is a good one to use, but any paper in this weight range will work.

Print out your bird and cut along the outside of all 6 pieces.

Glue one wing front to each wing back and let dry. When dry, punch a small hole in the large part of the wing where you will put the tack.

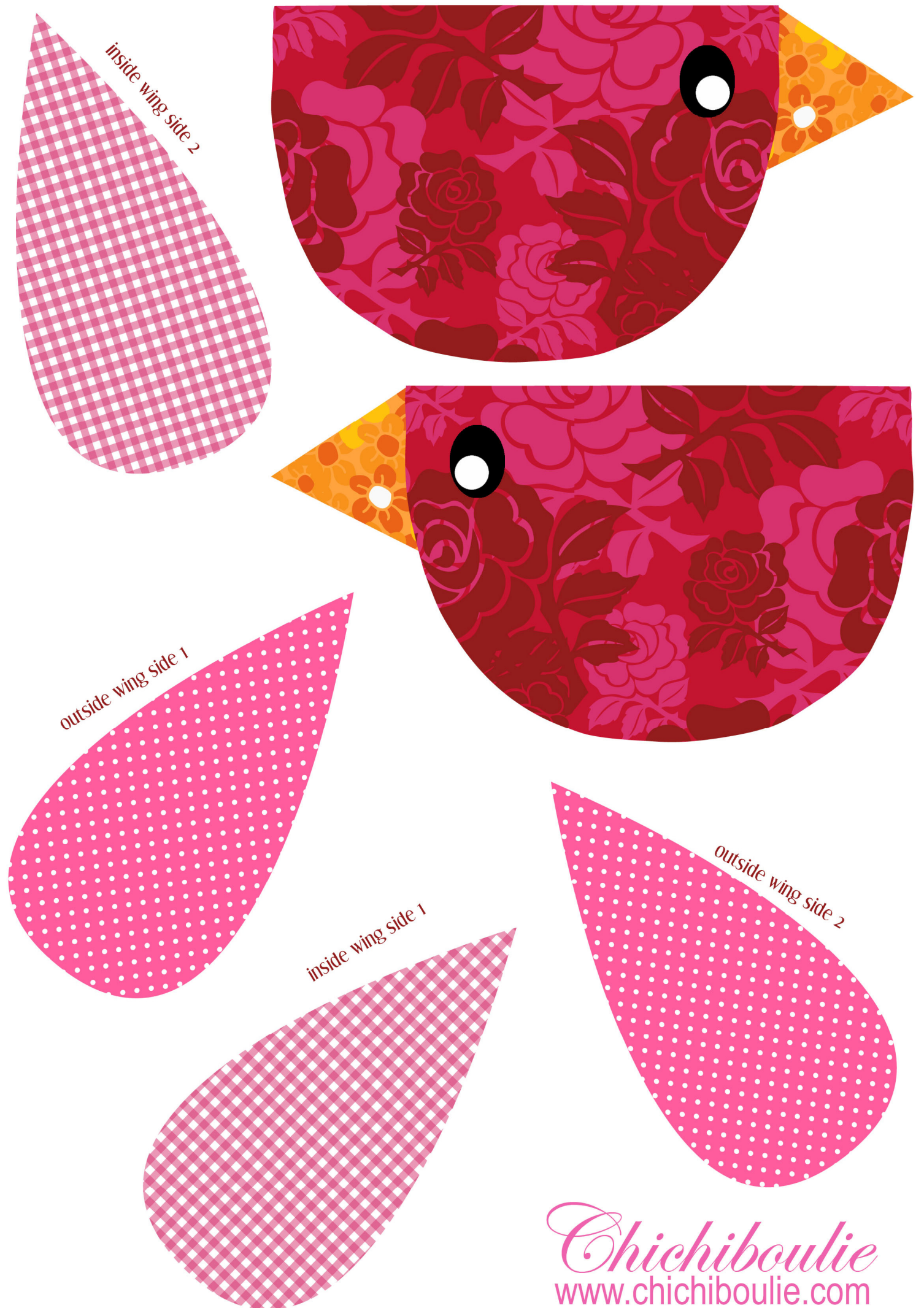
Decide where you want the wings on the bird and punch the pointy end of the tack through the bird body at that point on either side.

Once the wings are attached to the body, you can go ahead and glue the body pieces together, leaving a small unglued area at the bottom for the ribbon legs and at the top for a hanging ribbon.

Cut a length of ribbon equal to twice the length of 1 leg. Fold the ribbon in half at a 45° angle. Glue the ribbon inside the bird body and let dry. When dry, glue the bottom of the bird body closed.

Cut a second length of ribbon and tie together to create a hanging loop. Glue the tied ends inside of the bird and let dry. When dry, glue the top of the bird body closed.

Finish by hanging in a place of pride!
